Star's personal transformation from welfare fraud to conservative crusader has been chronicled by ABC's "20/20," Rush Limbaugh, *Readers Digest*, Dr. James Dobson, George Grant, the *Washington Times*, *Christianity Today*, *Charisma*, and *World Magazine*. Ms. Parker has also appeared on Hannity and Colms on Fox News.
